Limits to Confidentiality

Confidentiality is limited by conditions imposed by law where a young person discloses:

- a) Abuse to themselves or to another
- b) Intention to hurt themselves
- c) Intention to hurt another person
- d) If MSS staff suspects that a client is being abused or is at risk of abuse

In these situations, we are legally bound to report to Child Protection Services.

Your Rights

- 1. Clients have the right to contribute to any/all decision-making applicable to them.
- 2. Clients have the right to participate in the designing of their own treatment. plan.
- 3. Clients have the right to review and/or correct any personal information on file.

Fees

MSS has recently adopted a sliding scale fee model whereby a client pays according to the income levels of the individual or family and these will be determined at the time of the intake process. MSS is committed to ensuring that no one is turned away due to their inability to pay for counselling. Individuals are asked to have available any insurance coverage information they may have so as to assist us in determining the best means of cost coverage for counselling.

We offer counselling to individuals, children, couples and families and group therapy in various languages such as: Hindi, Gujrati, Kutchi, Arabic, Swahili & English.
